

1) March Magnets show, opening Friday, March 30, 6 to 9 pm. The Gallery will be cleared and painted over the March 17-18 weekend. Please bring your magnets by March 25, and beverages and snacks for the opening and the weekend Gallery shifts March 31 and April 1.

2) Still operating on a month-by-month lease basis.

3) The Board is meeting on March 19 to finalize the By-laws; they will be distributed to the members upon completion in advance of the planned vote at the May members meeting.

4) Signage. There will be a new vinyl banner sign installed along the front awning of the Gallery, and a new, larger sandwich board to place out front. The planned sign to be installed out in front of the entrance requires a variance from the city.

5) Gallery staffing. Several options to staffing a shift in the Gallery were discussed, such as substituting other tasks including cleaning areas throughout the building or the sink trap and clay buckets. This is an ongoing issue.

6) The motion to reduce the membership fee to \$550 has been passed by a majority of Guild members.

7) Meeting dates. Members' meetings are now scheduled for the first Monday of each month (April 2, May 7, June 4, etc.).

8) Fees for firings in the electric and raku kilns. Bisque firings are free of charge. There is a fee for all final firings: \$15 for the larger electric kiln, \$7 for the smaller electric kiln, \$10 per session for the larger raku and \$5 per session for the smaller raku kiln. Members will use a master form for final firings to record usage.

9) No policy decision has been reached on a "family membership," allowing more than one adult family member to use the Guild facilities under one fee structure.

10) Arvada Art Studio tour, Sept 29 and 30, 2007. How many Guild members plan to participate this year? Last year the Guild provided the blanket participation fee, however, this year we are considering individual members' participation for a \$15 participants fee. This allows the individual participant to have their name appear in the Art Studio tour program. The issue will be discussed at next month's member meeting.
